**Prompt:** How might you communicate your thoughts and feelings effectively to an elected official? Why might it be important to do so?

**Possible Response(s):** Students may offer a variety of plausible responses.

Students might offer one of the following responses and explain how each might be done effectively...

- in person, speak at a town meeting, write a letter, phone call, e-mail, fax, write a letter to an editor.
- Elected officials have a responsibility to represent the varied interests of large numbers of people and need citizens' input to make informed decisions.
