

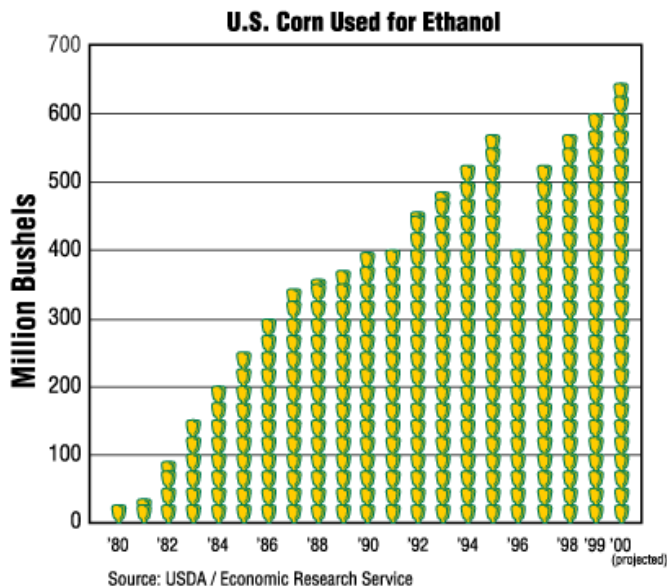

In 1990 around 400 million bushels of corn was used and in the year 2000 around 600 million bushels of corn was being used in the production of ethanol.
