

*Extended Response Item***Standard:** History 2**Cluster:** 6-8

A student finds a newspaper clipping that featured a headline quoting Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. He is quoted as saying the “segregation of the races is a good thing.” Knowing many of the ideas that Dr. King discussed during his lifetime, the student is not sure that the quotation is accurate.

Name one piece of information that a reader might look for to determine if a source is credible. Explain your answer.

**Response**

<b>Information</b>	<b>Explanation</b>
1. Date of the document	Determine if primary or secondary source, understanding of period in history
2. Author of document	Understand author’s position on issues, or author’s bias
3. Audience written for	Supporters or opponents of Dr. King
